

Indiana University School of Nursing Graduate Scholarships 2009-2010

Beverly Ross Scholarship for Riley Nurses

Open to enrolled students in the RN to BSN, RN to MSN, or a master's degree program. Applicant must be a registered nurse (RN) who is currently employed at James Whitcomb Riley Hospital for Children and is recognized by his/her colleagues as an excellent nurse, one who has contributed to the education of undergraduate nursing students. Financial need is not a criterion for selection. Personal statement must address contributions to the education of undergraduate nursing students, and nursing excellence.

Carol A. Shreibak Memorial Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus who have an interest in providing direct patient care, minimum of 3.0 GPA, and demonstrate financial need.

Dagna Simpson Nursing Scholarship

Open to graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus. Priority given to students in the **second degree BSN nursing option**.

Diane Groff Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Dotaline Allen Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at **IUPUI campus**.

Florence Nightingale Nursing Scholarship

Open to graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Frances G. Lehmann Nursing Scholarship

Open to students enrolled in the RN to BSN, RN to MSN, or master's degree programs at any Indiana University campus. Applicant must be a registered nurse (RN), have a record of community service, be a non-traditional student, and have a preference for work in the *mental health field*. Personal statement must address these requirements.

Garnet Keck Benzel Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Georgia Belle Nyland Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus. Preference given to a resident of Fulton County, Indiana. Second preference given to a resident of a county contiguous to Fulton County, Indiana. Third preference given to a resident of northern Indiana.

Howard L. Keach Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus. Preference is given to a resident of Lawrence County. Applicant must show evidence of scholastic ability and dependability, and must demonstrate financial need.

Jessie Cross Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus who are Indiana residents. Applicant must have completed at least one full academic year of study at Indiana University School of Nursing.

Kristen Pettijohn Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate nursing students at the *IUPUI campus*. Applicant must show interest in nursing education and in becoming a faculty member to teach future nursing students. Applicant must be passionate about nursing and exhibit compassion for those in need of health care. Personal statement must address these criteria.

Lambert Family Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled master's students entering the final year of the Nurse Practitioner Program at the IUPUI campus who have a minimum GPA of 3.5. Applicant must submit a personal statement that conveys personal passion for nursing; outlines plan to continue a career in nursing; tells how applicant has modeled a spirit of caring with a history of service to others; and discusses interest in oncology nursing.

Leona Adam/Frances Orgain Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Lois Latshaw Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus. Selection may be based on financial need or merit.

Marcy Smith Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus who have an interest in **critical care nursing**. Preference given to a graduates of **Kokomo High School (Kokomo, Indiana)**. Second preference given to a graduate from another high school in Howard County, Indiana. Third preference given to a graduate from Miami or Tipton Counties, Indiana.

Martha Akers Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Michelle A. White Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus. Applicant must be strong academically, skilled in patient and clinical care areas, and demonstrate interest in nursing research. Personal statement must address these criteria.

Molly Ward Greist Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at the IUPUI campus.

Montserrat Callangan-Mingus Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus who are of Asian descent (Asian-Americans or international students from Asia). Preference is given to Filipino students. Applicant must demonstrate financial need.

Nursing 2000 Graduate Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate nursing students at the IUPUI campus who are Indiana residents. Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to work in nursing in any of the eleven-county area served by Nursing 2000 (Bartholomew, Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Lawrence, Johnson, Marion, Monroe, Morgan, and Shelby). A competitive GPA is required and financial need is considered. Personal statement must address career plans.

Ruth A. Hamilton Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Ruth Deter Scholarship

Presented to outstanding graduate students in community health nursing. Given to promote the educational preparation of community health nurses.

Ruth Orum-Orgain Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus.

Susan Kay Nevins Nursing Scholarship

Open to enrolled graduate or undergraduate nursing students at any Indiana University campus. Preference will be given to applicant who is in clinical classes.

The Adam W. Herbert Graduate Fellowship (courtesy posting)

The Adam W. Herbert Graduate Fellowship was created through an endowment from the President's Fund for the purpose of supporting graduate study at Indiana University for graduates of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs). This endowment reflects the strong commitment of Indiana University's 17th President, Adam W. Herbert, for enhancing opportunities for underrepresented students and increasing diversity of the graduate student body, especially in the fields of science, technology and mathematics. The fellowship will be awarded each year to students who demonstrate strong academic excellence, high potential for success, and a commitment to the graduate study in the sciences. It is anticipated that up to five (5) multi-year fellowships for doctoral students and three (3) single year fellowships for masters students will be supported each year.

Tri Chi Nursing Scholarship

Open to graduate or undergraduate nursing students on any Indiana University campus who maintains a minimum GPA of 3.0 and are residents of Indiana. The scholarship may be renewed for up to two years without reapplying if the GPA is maintained.

Tyler Luke Mayse Neonatal Nursing Scholarship

Graduate nursing students in the final year of the Neonatal Nurse Practitioner program who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and demonstrate financial need may apply for this scholarship. Applicant's personal statement must address how they demonstrate dedication, passion and compassion.

William and Doris Rodie Dissertation Scholarship Award

The William and Doris Rodie Dissertation Scholarship Award scholarship was created to provide financial assistance to doctoral candidates in the Indiana University School of Nursing who are working on dissertations. Five \$2000 awards will be made in the 2008-2009 Academic year. The funds are to be used to offset dissertation expenses. All PhD students who have achieved candidacy and are actively working on their dissertation research are eligible to receive the award once. PhD students may apply for this award once they have successfully defended their dissertation research proposal. An abstract of the proposed dissertation research as well as a budget outlining how the monies will be used must accompany this application. Students also need a letter of support from the Chair of their Dissertation Committee.

The application deadline is February 1, 2009 and October 1, 2009. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete application packet on or before the deadline. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Dart-Opie Award

Acknowledges the outstanding graduate work by an RN to MSN student whose primary focus is care of the mentally ill. The award is to be granted upon completion of the student's MSN graduate education. The student selected must

have provided a significant contribution to the mental health community of the school and have a minimum GPA of 3.5.

Lee D. Fuller Award

Given to a PhD student in the doctoral psychiatric mental health nursing program who is at the proposal stage of writing his/her dissertation. The award is to help fund the student's research.
